



Lower Moutere School Board of Trustees' By-Election

Nominations will be invited for the election of 2 parent representatives to the Board of Trustees. A nomination form and a notice calling for nominations will be sent to all eligible voters next week.

Additional nomination forms will then also be available from the school office.

You can nominate another person to stand as a candidate, or you can nominate yourself (make sure you sign both parts of the form).

Nominations close at noon on Monday 5th November and may be accompanied by signed candidates' statements

The voting roll will be open for inspection at the school and available to be viewed during normal school hours

There will also be a list of candidates' names, as they come to hand, for inspection at the school. Voting (if more than 2 nominations are received) will close at noon on Monday 19th November 2018.
