Biking To and From School

We do not encourage cycling to school if your child is under 10 years of age. If your child is biking to school and the distance warrants it, please check that:

- ② Your child has and wears a helmet this is compulsory.
- ② Your child's bike is road safe and meets the standard in the Road Code.
- © Your child knows how to ride properly (uses hand signals when riding; is the bike the right size?).
- © You have practiced getting to and from school together.
- © Regular checks of your child's bike should be done.

It is also a recommendation from the NZTA that you should <u>always ride with your child if they're under 10 years</u> <u>old and then continue until you are sure they have the skills and confidence to ride in traffic.</u> We support this recommendation strongly.

PARKING

As you are aware parking outside of Lower Moutere school can get congested after school. For the safety of everyone, parents are requested to keep the area in front of the school gates clear at all times, this area is the school bus stop. Please park to the left of the school gate, or across the road. Thank you for your help in this matter.

Why it is important to be at school on time

We know mornings can be hectic, but we want to highlight the importance of your child arriving at school at least 5 minutes before the bell. This small change can make a significant difference to their day, and here's why:

- <u>Settling In & Ready to Learn:</u> Arriving early allows children to transition smoothly from home to school. They can unpack their bags, organise their belongings, and chat with friends before the learning day begins. This helps them feel calm and ready to focus when the bell rings.
- Avoiding the Rush & Stress: Rushing into class as the bell rings (or after!) can be stressful for children. It can lead to them feeling flustered and unprepared, making it harder to concentrate. Arriving early avoids this unnecessary stress.
- <u>Building a Sense of Community:</u> Those few minutes before school starts are a valuable time for children to interact with their peers and teachers. They can build friendships, share news, and feel connected to their school community.
- <u>Developing Responsibility & Time Management:</u> Arriving on time is a valuable life skill. By encouraging punctuality, we are helping children develop a sense of responsibility and learn the importance of time management.
- <u>Starting the Day Positively:</u> A calm and organised start to the day sets the tone for a positive learning experience. When children arrive on time, they are more likely to feel confident and engaged throughout the day.
- Respecting the Learning Time: When students arrive late the class is disrupted, and they miss out on valuable learning time.

We understand that unforeseen circumstances can sometimes cause delays. However, we encourage you to make every effort to ensure your child arrives at school at least 5 minutes before the bell.


