#### Dealing with inter-child conflict

If your child is having trouble with another child, please do not take matters into your own hands. We have an open door policy here at Lower Moutere School. We ask that you approach your child's teacher or one of our experienced Deputy Principal's to enlighten them about the issue. We will manage the issue as a school and communicate with the other family if necessary.

#### Communicating a change in care arrangements

We understand that from time to time there are changes in care arrangements for your children. Please let the school know when this occurs as this can often be unsettling for your child. If we are aware we can assist in either mitigating the impact this may be having on your child or view behaviour that is out of character through a different lens.

#### Coming to school really matters!

One of the things we are continuing to focus on in 2025 is student attendance. You will hear us talking about this with you, with our students and it remains a strong subject of conversation in the staff room.

If a student misses one day of school every two weeks, they miss more than a whole year of school by 16 years of age. As a parent or caregiver, you, alongside our school, play a key role in building strong habits of regular school attendance.

All students are legally required to attend school every day and it is a shared responsibility to make sure students attend and engage in learning from when they first start school. Please let the school know if your child is going to be absent or intends to be absent for a portion of the school term for whatever reason, like a tangi or medical procedure. Family holidays or taking time off for extracurricular activities (not organised by school) are not acceptable reasons for being absent.

If you're struggling at home with getting your child to school, talk to us.

If you are finding it hard to get your child to school, please talk with us so we can work together. Our school is committed to supporting your child to attend school.

#### **Bus Lines**

Ten to three is a very busy time at our front gate. We are fortunate to have two bus services that are available for eligible families to catch. These buses need space when they arrive to turn and safely park. We have a yellow line painted on the footpath outside our school. This signifies a no parking zone. Over the coming weeks we will endeavour to add some more indicating lines and further signage to clarify where to park and where not to park.

Students waiting for the bus, assemble between the pool sheds and staffroom. Their attendance on the bus is recorded on our rolls. If your child is not catching the bus please ensure you have informed the office.

The Board of Trustees is currently working on another option to improve the parking options in front of our school. Further information will be available in due course. Thank you for your assistance in helping us improve the safety for everyone at our front gate.

## School gates

We have a number of younger students who are known to see a gate and will head out onto the road. Keeping the gates closed is vitally important to their safety. If you go through a gate, we ask that you check that it closes behind you. Thanks for your on-going support with this.

Just a reminder that if you need to pick your child up early from school for an appointment or any other reason, please come through the office to let us know. Whilst at school we must ensure we know where our students are. Thankyou - Your help is appreciated!
