SWIMMING SEASON SOON TO START!



Our school swimming pool is now having some maintenance undertaken before filling with the intention of swimming starting in early November. Class teachers will let you know when each class will swim. Pool keys will also be for sale from 12 November, for our school families only, at \$70 a key.



Last week ...saw our school team of Evolocity enthusiasts take to the track and race their school-designed electric bike! What is Evolocity!?? It is where school-age students design, build and compete with their own electric vehicles. School age teams or individuals build a vehicle (either a bike

or with 3+ wheels) powered by a standard 350W electric motor, controller and two 12V gel cells. Innovation is encouraged as students strive to make their vehicle the fastest with the least drag, and able to cope with the demands of a tight street circuit. The Engineering Design Award encourages teams to build innovative features, such as smart monitoring or object detection and avoidance. The final result was our school team (the youngest by far!) winning three out of the four sections and then returning to school with proud grins, more than a mile wide!





District Athletics

We look forward to hosting the local district athletics champs at Lower Moutere, Tuesday 19th November for all 8-10 year olds and then Wednesday 20th for all 11 year olds plus. We are holding a Sausage Sizzle on both of these days – if any parent has some time to spare and would be able to look after the cooking, we would really appreciate it. Swimming Season: 25 November 2024 – March 2025



Penguins Squad: (Swimming NZ Level 2)

7 years and over, who are water confident and can swim a basic freestyle. Coach is not in the pool with children. (2 sessions/week: Monday/Wednesday)



Dolphins Squad: (Swimming NZ Level 3)

Focus on correct freestyle, backstroke and breaststroke technique. (2 sessions/week: Monday/Wednesday)



Orcas Squad:

10 years and over, confident swimmers that wish to improve their techniques (including butterfly) and increase their endurance. (2 sessions/week: Monday/Wednesday)

Trains 4 sessions/week (Monday-Thursday), may attend meets. For swimmers who still want to improve technique and train as a squad but may not want to swim competitively.

Trains 4 sessions/week (Monday-Thursday), intense focus on perfecting stroke technique, speed, and endurance. Opportunity to compete at Swimming NZ meets.
