I am pleased to announce that after an extended period of sick leave Maureen Wilkinson is returning to the New Entrant Room this term for two days a week. Mo will be working on Thursday and Friday. I am pleased to announce that Rachel Woods has agreed to stay on and lead the teaching in our New Entrant room working closely with Mo to provide a seamless education for our Tamariki.

This term promises to be another exciting one, packed with engaging learning opportunities for all our Tamariki. Our overarching theme this term is: Let there Be Light - This will primarily be a science focus delving into questions such as: What is light? Where does light come from? How are shadows made? 
